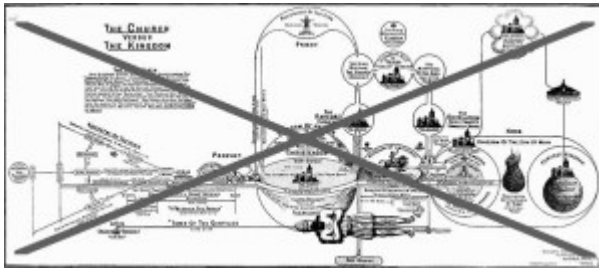


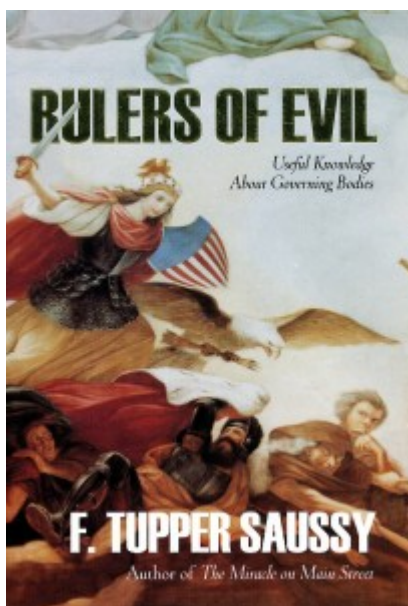
# Dispensationalism and Its Influence on Eschatology

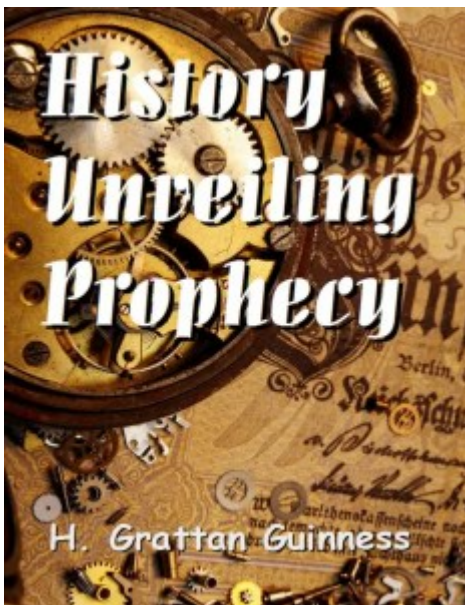
## [Daniel, by Isaac Newton](#)

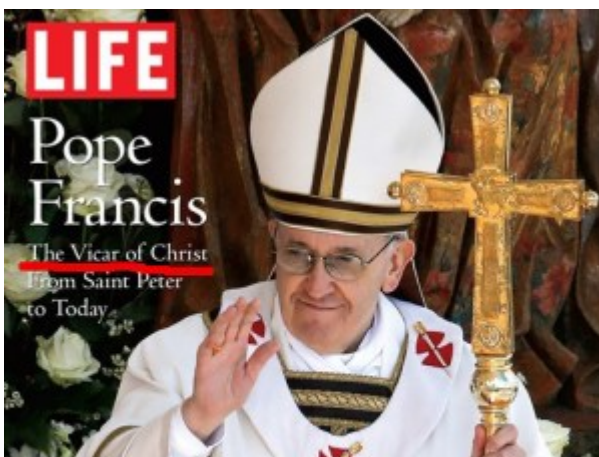
## The Seventy Weeks and the Great Tribulation – By Philip Mauro

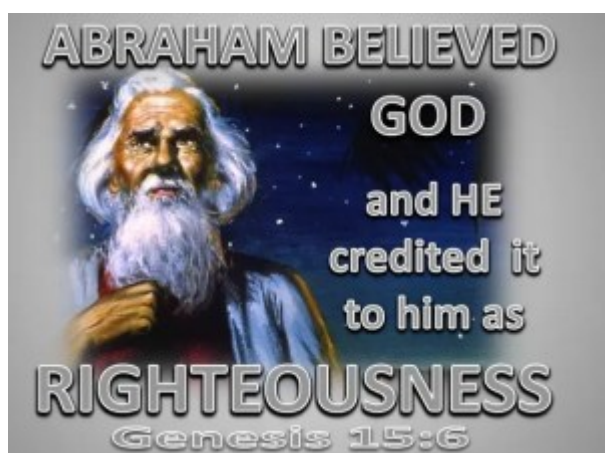
## Seven Things You May Not Know about Christmas

## The Two Babylons Chapter IV. Section II – Justification by Works

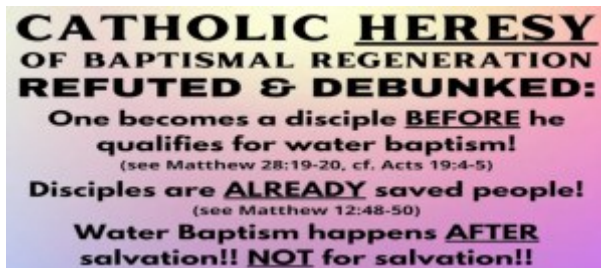
